ANNA MARIA ZANETTI

Anna Maria Zanetti graduated from Conservatorio "Benedetto Marcello" of Venice in 1981 under the guidance of Mario Argentieri. She then continued her training with Maria Tipo, A.Specchi, Hector Moreno, Norberto Capelli and Lola Tavor. She won the competitions of Stresa, Albenga, Savona, "C. Zecchi", performing piano duos with David Vicentini.

She has taken parts in numerous concerts in Italy, Europe, Asia and received critical and audience acclaim by performing an extended 4 hands and two pianos repertoire. She has served as repetiteur (piano accompanist) in many theatres: Pavia, Pisa, Lucca, Bolzano, Trento, Rovigo. She has participated in many vocal and Lieder concerts, as well as chamber concerts.

She has served as repetiteur in many courses and competitions for singers and instrumentalists. For many years she has moreover worked as piano accompanist for the GAV Orchestra (Youth String Orchestra of Veneto): with such orchestra she won the "Victor de Sabata Award". She played for RAI (Italian television) and has worked in many prestigious theatres in Italy and Europe. She moreover collaborated with soprano Luciana Serra.

She has recently joined the jury of the International Music Competition "Città di Padova". She has taught piano for many years using the Suzuki method in the only recognised school of Veneto, in Treviso, as well as at the "Conservatorio Francesco Venezz" of Rovigo. Her young pupils have often won the first prize or won top places in competitions nationwide and abroad.

She is Professor of Piano Accompaniment at the "Conservatorio Francesco Venezz" of Rovigo.
