MARCO RICCIARELLI

Education

Marco Ricciarelli studied piano under the guidance of M° Alfredo Speranza and graduated with top marks from the "Conservatorio G. Frescobaldi" of Ferrara. He then continued his training with M° Annamaria Pennella in Napoli as well as with M° Aquiles Delle Vigne at the Academy "Musici Artis" of Brussels. He moreover attended Chamber Music courses by M° Bruno Canino.

Early life and career

When he was 11 years old, Marco Ricciarelli won first prizes at piano competitions nationwide and abroad. After winning the competition "F. Liszt" of Livorno, when he was 13, he was invited to the European Liszt Centre and took part in concerts in Hungary.

Marco Ricciarelli performed solo and chamber music concertos in Italy and abroad (in Europe and South America) and gained great critical and audience acclaim. He collaborated with Canino and Ballista at the Santa Cecilia Auditorium in Bologna. He took part and performed the concertos for two pianos of J. S. Bach at the Misano Piano Festival. He is member of several chamber music ensembles and won second prize at the International Chamber Music Competition "Provincia di Caltanissetta".

He has also served as repetiteur for the Social Theatre of Rovigo and has moreover recorded for Fabula Classica (Ermitage). He currently teaches Piano Accompaniment at the "Conservatorio Francesco Veneze" of Rovigo.
