- perform the pieces studied during the year in concert situations.

Content of the course

The course will enable students to perform pieces from the solo repertoire of the main percussion instruments. They will also master the most prominent techniques of execution.

One concert piece for timpani (chosen from the ones studied during the year)

One piece for set-up or, alternatively, a piece with piano or with another percussionist
